

Chief O'Neill's Favourite (D mixolydian)

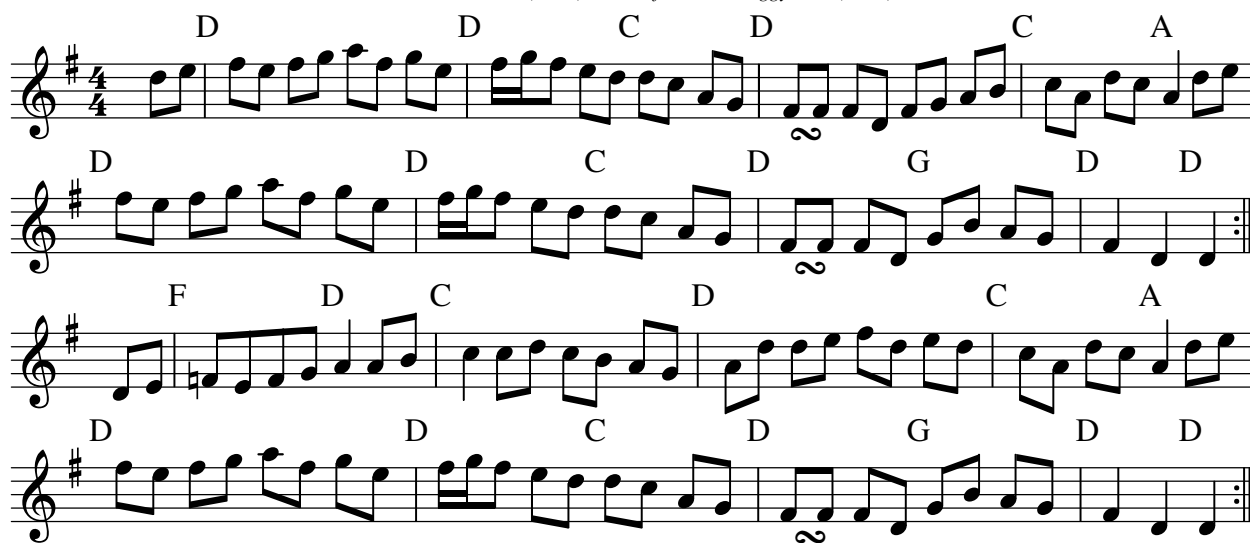
traditional Irish Hornpipe

Chicago Police Chief Francis O'Neill (1848-1936) was flute player and tune collector.

This tune he collected from fiddler Edward Cronin, who named it after O'Neill.
